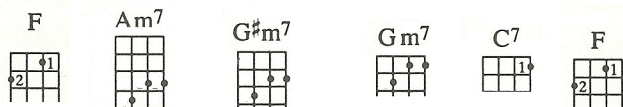


Sheik of Araby

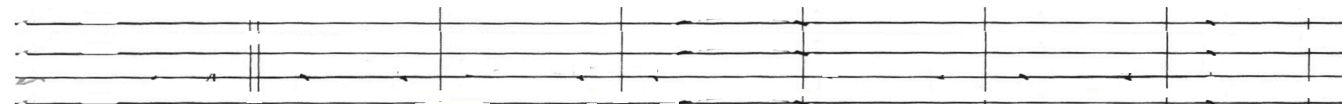

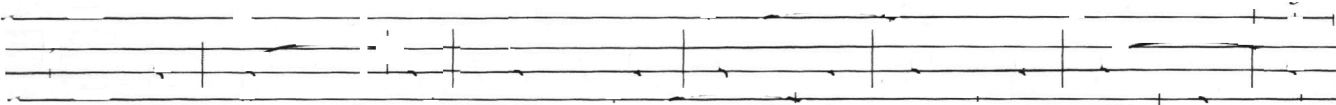
