

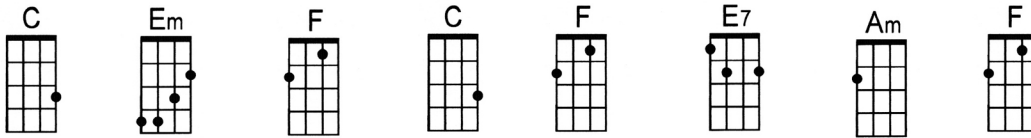


# Somewhere over the Rainbow
